If you are being represented by a **mandatary other than your counsel**, the mandatary must provide to the Tribunal a written mandate signed by you.

No counsel may act on behalf of a party if the sole object of the application is to recover a sum of money that constitutes a small claim. Refer to the Tribunal's website for further information on what constitutes a small claim.
